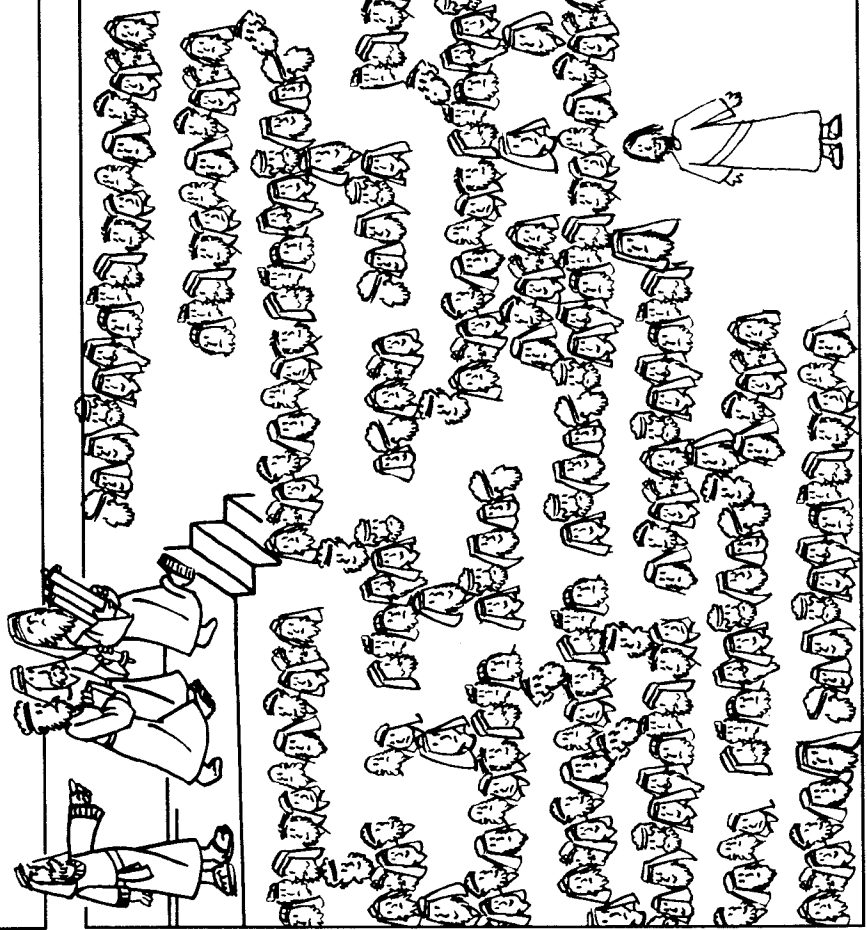

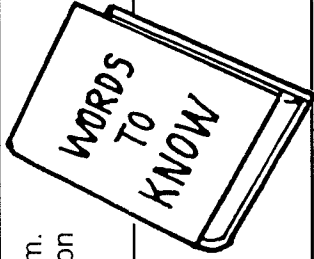
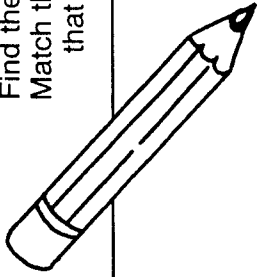
## Paying Taxes to Caesar
